The mission of the Young Professional Board (YPB) is to increase awareness of One Summit, support the functioning of the organization, and its mission to build resilience and facilitate growth in pediatric cancer patients and their siblings through mentorship, experiential learning, storytelling, and community engagement with U.S. Navy SEALs.

One Summit (OS) is committed to doing everything possible to ensure the long-term success of our programs. We maintain a lean annual operating budget to ensure funding goes directly to our programs and infrastructure. Therefore, One Summit relies heavily on its engaged Young Professionals Board for year-round support related to fundraising, executing events, raising awareness, and more. The YPB's reinforcement and guidance provide the resources and confidence to achieve our goals and expectations. Each of our markets (Boston, New York, San Diego, and Virginia Beach) have its own Young Professionals Board Chair and will organize OS fundraising and awareness events in their respective regions.

Expectations and Responsibilities

Below is a list of expectations and responsibilities required to participate in the Young Professionals Board.

- Act as an OS ambassador by building awareness through fundraising and events:
 - Engage in One Summit social media campaigns to extend the mission's reach to a broader community.
 - With other YPB members in your region, design, plan, attend, support, and volunteer to execute One Summit events and promote marquis fundraising campaigns. At least one per year.
 - Attend and/or volunteer at One Summit programs and events, when possible. At least one per year.
 - Help secure sponsorships and auction items for special events and OS programs.
- Contribute to One Summit financially:
 - Commit to fundraising \$500 per year individually and \$3,000 total with your YPB regional colleagues (Boston, New York, Virginia Beach, or San Diego).
 - Strongly encouraged to participate in our Silver Star Supporters program and contribute a donation of \$25 per month.
- Participate in scheduled board meetings and/or phone calls (quarterly).

- Recruit at least two new potential YPB members
- Must serve for a one-year term
 - A term is renewable dependent on member's ability to meet expectations outlined above

Benefits

Young Professionals will have opportunities to network, develop skills, plan fundraisers and events, and grow as leaders while learning about board membership and nonprofit business operations.

- Network with other like-minded young professionals in a variety of industries
